New Year's Resolutions and fresh starts are all around us. Did you realize that they could also save you money?



Eat Healthier. Eating healthy does not have to be expensive! The fat, salt, and sweets are the expensive items. One bag of chips can cost \$4. For the same money, you could buy 5 pounds of potatoes, which contain vitamins and fiber.

Pay Down Debt. Paying down debt has the added benefit that your credit score goes up with the less amount of debt you have. That means the next time you borrow money, you'll pay less for that loan.

Quit Smoking. A pack a day habit can cost between \$1,825 -\$3,650 per year. You will also save on insurance premiums.

Exercise Regularly. If people are eating right and exercising 3 times a week for 20 minutes or more, they see prescription costs decrease by 70% and medical costs by 30%. Plus, exercise can dramatically improve conditions like diabetes, high blood pressure, cholesterol and heart disease.

Build up an Emergency Fund. Stress less when you have spare cash in case of an emergency, so you do not have to use expensive options like high APR credit cards and payday loans.
