#### Watch out for these scams:

- Lottery winnings where you receive a check and letter stating you have won the lottery
- Online auction or personal ad sites stating you have won money - be cautious when giving your personal information and receiving payment via check
- Text messages requesting account and PIN information be verified in order to reactivate debit or credit cards
- Automated phone calls requesting account information to verify direct deposits from the Social Security Administration
- Emails urging verification of account information by clicking on an embedded link
